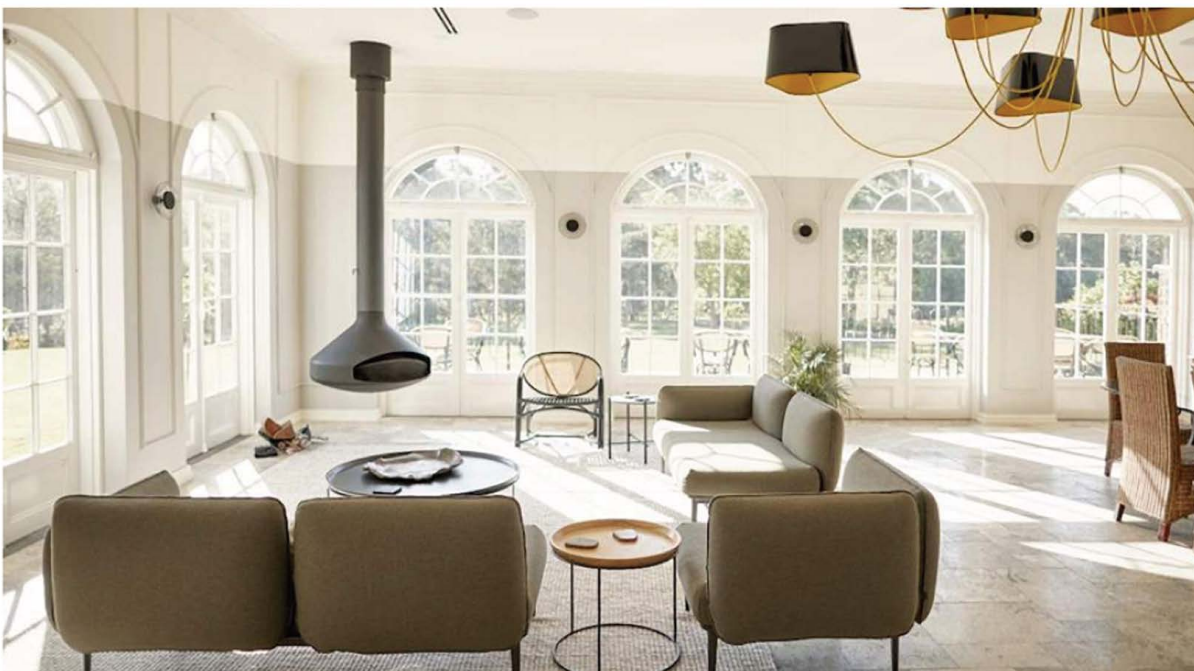

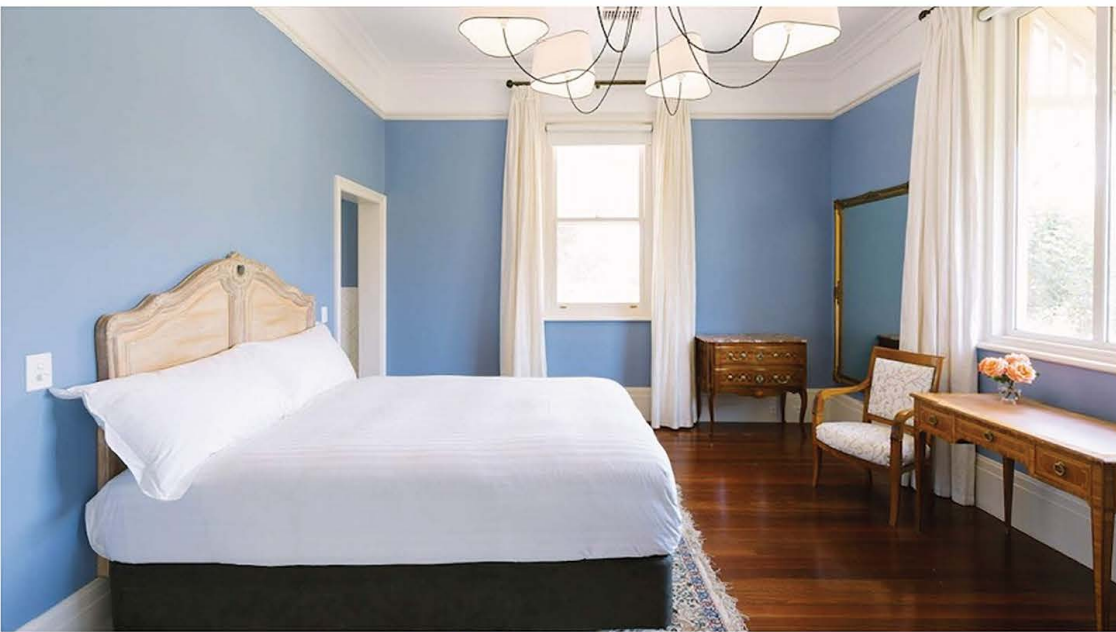
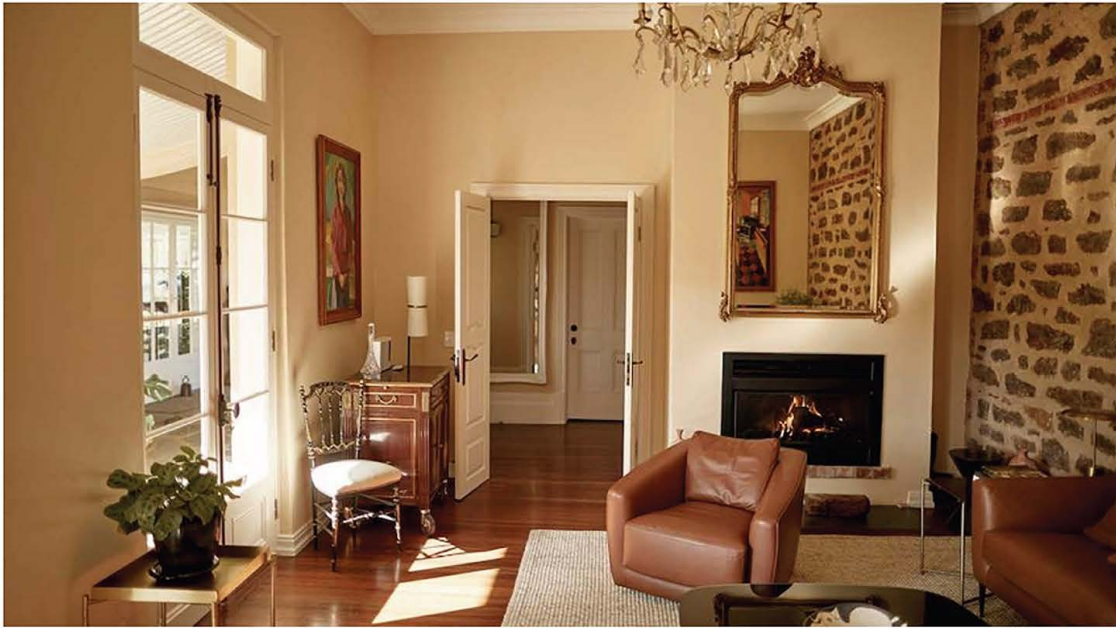


The historic, 160-year-old residence sits in the very heart of the Barossa Valley, and is surrounded by rare Grenache vines and picturesque gardens.
